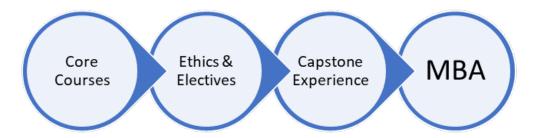

The University of Dayton MBA is offered in both an on-campus or online format. It is a 30-credit hour* program consisting of core managerial decision-making courses, an ethics course, a capstone experience, and electives. The elective courses may be chosen in a variety of areas.

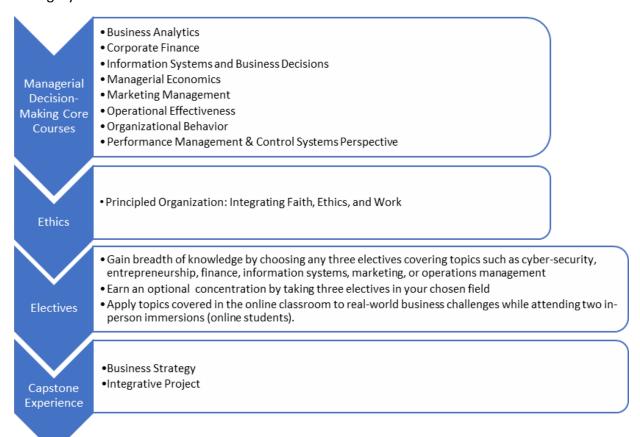


The on-campus program offers concentrations in cyber security management, finance, and marketing. The online program offers concentrations in business analytics and marketing.

*For the student with a non-business degree, or who lacks current coursework or work experience in key areas of undergraduate business study, foundation courses are required (up to an additional 15 hours).

Admission Requirements

- An earned undergraduate degree (3.0 GPA is preferred)
- Official academic records from all previously attended institutions
- A current resume
- An essay response
- GMAT/GRE scores may be requested after review of application materials
- Letters of recommendation (online students)
- A personal statement is optional

Once you are accepted into the MBA Program, you will work collaboratively with your advisor to develop a program just for you.

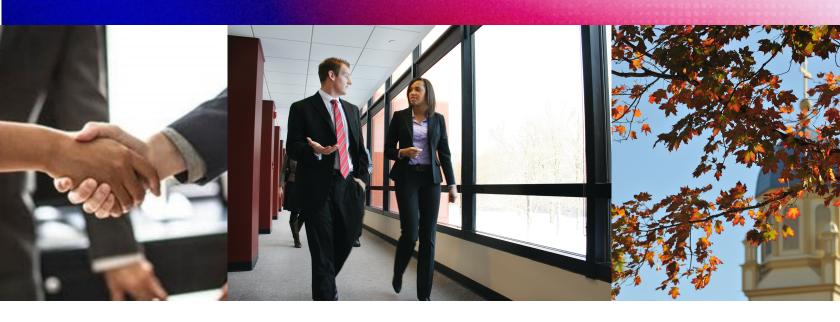
