**DROP/REFUND REFERENCE**

<b>Term</b>	First Friday of the Full Term (Drop Deadline)	Second Friday of the Full Term (1 week after Drop Deadline)	Third Friday of the Full Term (2 weeks after Drop Deadline)
<b>Part A</b>	100%	65%	N/A
<b>Full</b>	100%	65%	50%
<b>Part B</b>	100%	65%	50%

Each student has the opportunity to drop a class or classes once the term has begun. Dropping classes within the drop period does not affect academic transcripts. Students have until the first Friday, until 11:59 PM EST, after Full term start date, to drop a class and receive a 100% refund. Students have until the second Friday, until 11:59 PM EST, after Full term start date, to drop a class and receive a 65% refund. For Full Term and Part B courses only, students have until the third Friday, until 11:59 PM EST, after Full term start date, to drop a class and receive a 50% refund.

A student may withdraw from a course without record during the first week of Part A or Part B courses and during the first two weeks of a Full term course. During weeks 2-4 of a Part A or Part B course, students may withdraw and a W will be placed on their transcript. The same is true for weeks 3-8 of a Full term course. These time frames are considered the W period. Once the W period ends, a student may not withdraw from the course.
