The WGS program searches for one student intern in policy to assist with the work of the Women's Center during the academic year. The student in this position works with the Center's director, Dr. Lisa Borello, to research, write, and present on policy issues that affect the UD community. The student works onsite for 8-10 hours per week and can receive 6 credit hours of WGS course credit for the year-long internship. Completing the internship will fulfill half of the requirements toward a WGS minor.

Requirements:

- *At least 6 credit hours of WGS and/or policy-related course work
(Courses not listed as WGS courses but with significant gender focus count!)
- *A clear commitment to gender equity and inclusion
- *Excellent oral and written communication skills
