Our Lady of Safe Travel—A statue transported from Mexico to Manila in 1626 and housed in different places. In 1929 it was solemnly crowned in Manila and then returned to its most usual place, Antipolo.



Our Lady of the Turumba—Statue of Our Lady of Sorrows found in the water in the eighteenth century and located at Pakil on the Laguna de Baie. "Turumba" is the name of a song in Mary's honor sung by the people who brought the statue to the church.
