



# Bachelor's Plus Master's Program



## Highlights of the BPM Program

- BPM Program participants pay tuition equal to the School of Education and Health Sciences Master's rate (approx. 33% discount off the regular MBA tuition rate)
- Tuition discount extends for up to four (4) consecutive terms after graduation from UD undergraduate studies
- Students have the ability to take one semester off for an approved internship or co-op without penalty
- ***The BPM Program does not apply to online graduate programs***

## Step 1: Apply to the BPM Program

Submit your BPM application: [go.udayton.edu/mba-bpm](https://go.udayton.edu/mba-bpm). Your BPM application should be submitted at the beginning of your senior year, but no later than your last semester as an undergraduate (or subsequent to completion of 60 semester hours of undergraduate work and prior to being awarded the baccalaureate degree).

### Requirements:

- A GPA of 3.0 or better
- Acceptance into the MBA program. ***Acceptance into the BPM program does not automatically mean acceptance into the MBA program.***

## Step 2: Apply to the MBA Program

Submit your MBA program application: <https://dayton.force.com/graduate/>. ***You must be admitted to the MBA program prior to graduating with your UD undergraduate degree in order to take advantage of the BPM discount.***

In addition to submitting your MBA program application, you must also submit the following:

- A copy of all transcripts from other schools (do not need to submit UD transcripts)
- A copy of your resume
- An essay answering the prompts listed on the MBA website here: [https://udayton.edu/business/graduate-academics/master\\_of\\_business\\_administration/admission\\_requirements.php](https://udayton.edu/business/graduate-academics/master_of_business_administration/admission_requirements.php)
- An optional letter of recommendation or personal statement
- Acceptable GMAT or GRE official scores ***may be requested***

All items must be submitted prior to an admission decision.

## Step 3: Contact the MBA Program

Contact the MBA Program at 937-229-3733 or [MBA@udayton.edu](mailto:MBA@udayton.edu) to schedule an advising appointment after completing Steps 1 and 2 but prior to undergraduate graduation.

## MBA Concentrations

MBA electives can be used to complete an optional concentration in Finance, Marketing, or Cyber Security. Finance, Marketing, and Cyber Security concentrations require nine (9) elective hours in the respective discipline.

## Financial Aid

- All BPM students are eligible for a tuition discount for up to four (4) consecutive terms after graduation from UD undergraduate studies

## Additional Information

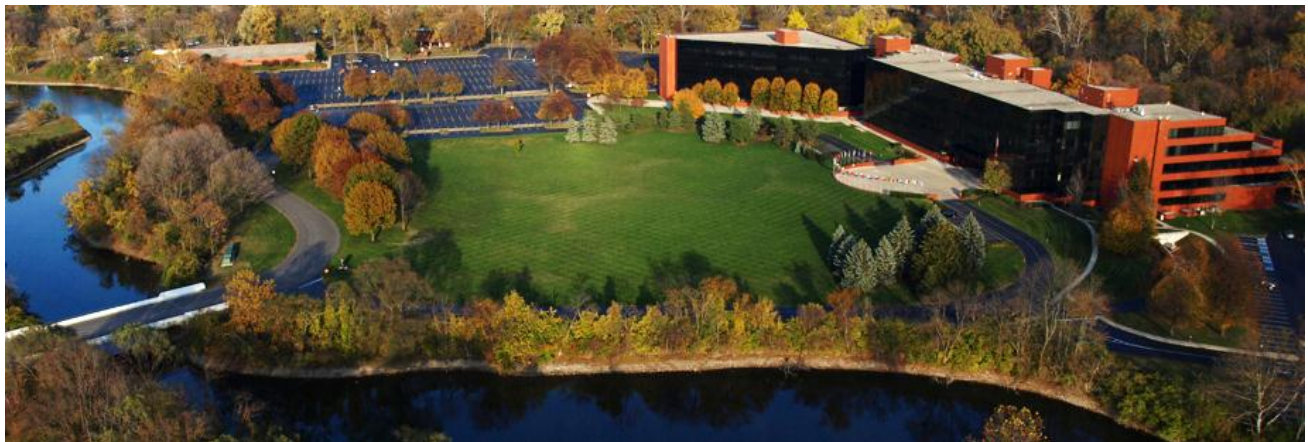
- In order to stay in good academic standing and to graduate with an MBA, students must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA
- In general, we do not allow double counting of undergraduate with graduate credit in the MBA program
- Non-business undergraduate students may also qualify for the BPM
- Students should work with the MBA office to ensure planned graduation requirements are being met
