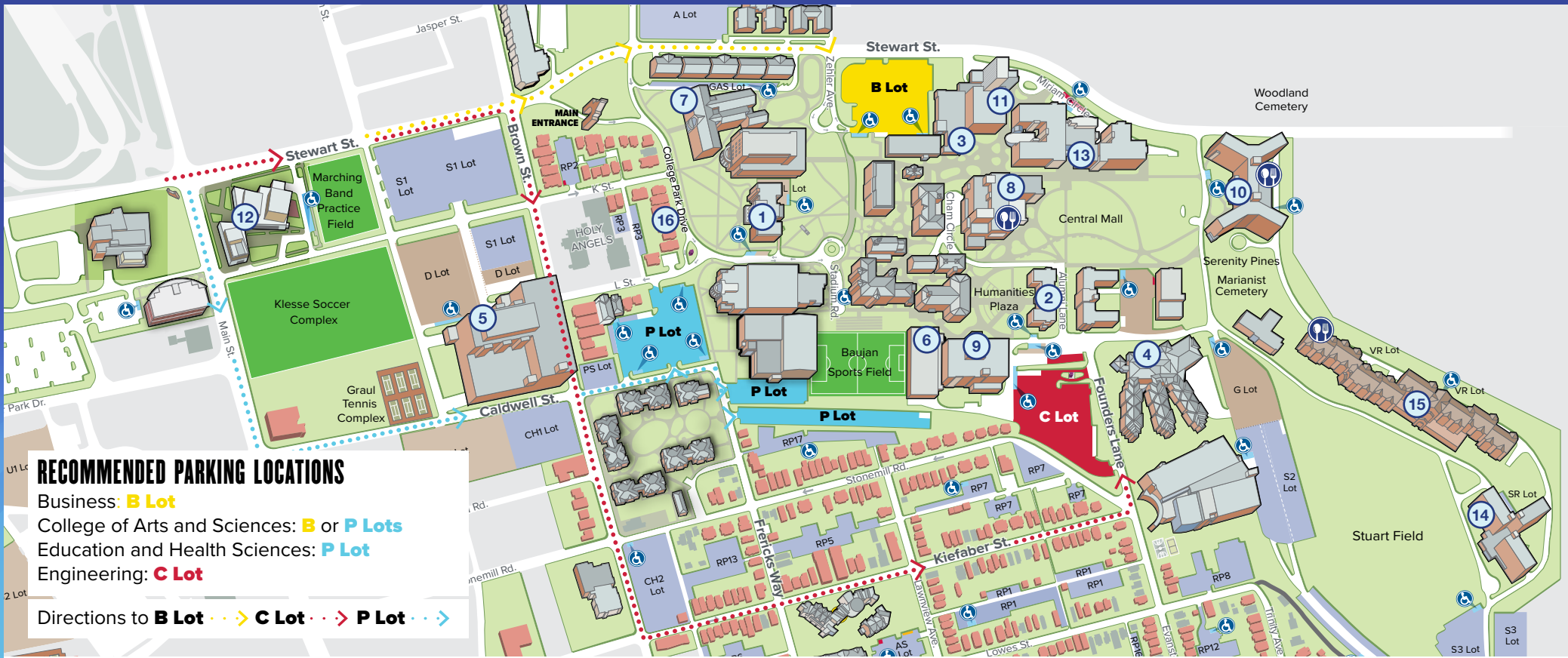
You can also see a sample room in Marycrest Complex (first-year residence hall) as part of the campus tour leaving from Albert Emanuel Hall.
