### **Employment History**

*Adjunct Instructor of Mathematics and Statistics for Sinclair CC (2012 – 2015; 2017 – present)* While living in Denmark from July, 2012 until Jan, 2015, I taught one or more online math classes for Sinclair Community College in Dayton, Ohio each semester, including summers. When I returned from Denmark in January, 2015 I continued teaching part-time for Sinclair with both face-to-face classes as well as online classes until resuming my full-time teaching duties once again in August, 2015 through December, 2017. I have been an adjunct again at Sinclair since January, 2018.

Having returned from my 2.5 years living abroad in Denmark I resumed my fulltime teaching position at Sinclair Community College in Dayton, Ohio. I continue to teach a wide variety of classes at Sinclair, including Business Math, Introductory Statistics, Business Statistics, Quantitative Reasoning, Math in the Health Sciences, College Algebra, Precalculus, Analytic Geometry and Trigonometry, Business Calculus, Calculus I and several Mathematics Topics classes. I teach face-to-face classes, as well as numerous online classes.

*Adjunct Instructor of Mathematics and Statistics at UD (2015 – 2016; 2017 – present)*

I currently teach part-time at the University of Dayton in Dayton, Ohio. My teaching duties have included a topics class for the Mathematics Department and statistics classes for both the Math Department and the Decision Sciences Department.

*Adjunct Instructor of Mathematics and Statistics at WSU (2017 – present)*

I taught part-time at Wright State University in Dayton, Ohio. My teaching duties included STT 1600, Introduction to Statistics and MTH 1280, College Algebra.

Since January of 2008 I have been teaching at least one online math or statistics course (and usually two or three) every quarter.
