Music Education Courses: The following music education curriculum is typically followed by a candidate *with a previous music degree*. These courses are in addition to courses required by the Department of Teacher Education (see above). If the candidate has not previously completed core music courses such as music theory, ear training, music history, and performance courses (lessons, ensembles), additional undergraduate courses will be required to enter this licensure program. All students must complete an aural skills evaluation prior to acceptance, and a performance audition for candidates without an undergraduate music degree.

One or more of the courses listed below could be waived or substituted based upon a candidate's previous studies and music background and approval of the music education coordinator. Graduate music courses may be substituted for undergraduate music courses with the approval of the music education coordinator. Consult the music education coordinator for more information.

_____ The program requires EDT 507 The Profession of Teaching (and lab) to be taken as the first EDT course. Continuation in the license preparation program is dependent upon successful completion of EDT 507 and accompanying lab.

_____ EDT 570 and Lab may be substituted with MUS 340 Music Education for Diverse Student Populations in Inclusive Settings. EDT 602 may be substituted with MUS 335 Classroom Music Methods.

_____ Students need a minimum GPA of 2.5 in the teaching field course work.
