Dear BSN Applicant,

We are excited about your interest in the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at the University of Dayton! This unique program concurrently enrolls students at UD and Sinclair College to earn an Associate's Degree and a Bachelor's Degree in nursing. To matriculate to Sinclair's Nursing Program in year three (3), students must receive a proficient rating or higher in each area of the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) (Reading 69%, Math 63%, Science 45%, and English 60%). Students may choose to take the TEAS prior to starting UD; however, all students must complete the TEAS with proficient scores in all four areas by **March 1 of year 2** (sophomore year). Students have **three attempts** to score proficient in all four areas of the TEAS; proficient scores carry forward (ex. If you score proficient on math, science, and reading and below proficient in English, your proficient scores will carry-forward and you will focus on the English portion to bring the score up to proficient). Any student who does not achieve proficient scores in all four areas by the third attempt and by March 1 of sophomore year is no longer eligible for the UD BSN Pathway Program.

It is important to "prepare" prior to taking the ATI, TEAS assessment. Students have the option and are encouraged to take a one-credit TEAS Prep Independent Study course fall term, sophomore year through UD. This course provides a test prep for the TEAS that students work through independently and then complete the TEAS exam prior to the end of the term. All students are required to complete the TEAS by **March 1, of year 2 (sophomore year)** regardless if they take the Independent Study Prep Course or choose to take it independently.

When you register to take the TEAS your registration includes one transcript that will be automatically sent to U of Dayton BSN. ATI tracks your number of attempts; not sending UD an initial transcript does not mean it will not count, the attempt will still be calculated as an attempt. Enclosed in this packet you will find directions to set up your account with ATI to take the TEAS and navigate their webpage. Students who do not complete the TEAS by the **March 1 date, year 2**, are no longer eligible for the UD BSN Pathway program. See ATI, TEAS registration and testing information below.


