- promote American students’ critical thinking about the role and position of the United States in the world

Can my UD course collaborate with an IEP course? (updated for Fall 2015 schedule)

The schedule of IEP classes is the same from term to term. Some IEP courses are easier for IEP teachers to plan a course collaboration with a UD course.
