



### **After Hours Access Policy Agreement**

Requests to receive rolling after-hours access to the MEC space may take up to three business days to process. Students can gain after-hours access to the MEC lounge by agreeing to the terms in this agreement. Your student id number will be needed to activate card swipe access. After-hours access is only available to students who are in good standing as defined by the University of Dayton's Community Standards.

Card access will be available from 5pm – 10pm weekdays, and 9am - 10pm on Saturdays and Sundays. Students may remain in the space after 10pm, but are not permitted to prop the doors.

After an orientation to the MEC space conducted by the administrative assistant for the Multi-Ethnic Education and Engagement Center, students will sign this document to express their agreement with the following:

- Students will not use the space to sleep or to host non-registered events.
- Students will use the space in a way that is respectful to the MEC staff and the mission of MEC.
- Students should ensure that the space is kept clean.
- Students accept full responsibility for the conduct of their guests and the appropriate use of the space and technology.
- Students will not leave guests in the MEC space unchaperoned.
- Students will not use the MEC space to conduct personal business.
- MEC may rescind the use of the space at any time.
- Students will follow University protocol and maintain proper distance and health standards.
- Masks are not required for vaccinated individuals.
